Josey Wales is a fictional character created by author Asa Earl Carter (writing under the pseudonym Forrest Carter as a supposed Cherokee) for his 1973 novel The Outlaw: Josey Wales.

Asa Earl Carter was a 1950's segregationist speech writer and later Western novelist. He co-wrote George Wallace's well-known pro-segregation line of 1963, "Segregation now, segregation tomorrow, segregation forever". In 1970, he ran in the Democratic primary for governor of Alabama on a segregationist ticket.

Mattaponi Sundowners – Rules and Stage Conventions

- **SASS Rules**: All SASS Rules are in affect; unless documented here, address during the Shooter Safety Meeting or specifically stated in the stage description for a given stage.
- Round Over Berm: A round fired over the berm is a Match DQ, excluding shotguns.
- <u>"No Alibi"</u>: All matches at Mattaponi are "no alibi" matches. "Once the first round goes down range, the competitor is committed to the stage and must finish the stage to the best of his or her ability. Reshoots/restarts are not awarded for ammunition or firearm malfunctions. However, if there is a range failure (failure of props, timer, or the range officers) beyond the competitor's control, a restart may be granted. On a reshoot/restart, the competitor starts over clean, carrying only accrued safety penalties forward. Restarts shall be allowed for a competitor to achieve a "clean" start up to the point at which the first round goes down range. Multiple restarts by the same shooter, that in the judgment of the R.O. are seen to be taking advantage, will not be entertained as they are not in the spirit of the game."
- <u>SASS Stage Conventions</u>: Unless specifically stated in the stage description for a given stage, all SASS Stage Conventions are in affect.
- <u>Shotgun Knockdown Misses</u>: Unless specifically stated in the stage description for a given stage and pursuant to SASS rules, all shotgun knockdown targets may be reengaged until down, aka "Comstock Rule".
- Loading on the Move: Loading on the move is permitted pursuant to SASS rules.
- Drawing on the Move: Drawing on the move is permitted pursuant to SASS rules.
- <u>Muzzle Position</u>: When there is a risk of a prop blocking the muzzle of a firearm, the muzzle must be positioned downrange of the prop, as determined by the Range Officer. For example: shooting through the window of a store front or shooting beside a wall.
- <u>End of Stage</u>: Unless otherwise directed by a Range Officer, after a stage has been completed the shooter will safely retrieve rifle, shotgun, and pistols and move them to the unloading table. The shooters firearms will not leave the unloading table until they have been verified "cleared" by a Range Officer.
- <u>Coaching</u>: Any shooter who wishes to not receive coaching must state their preference at the beginning of <u>each</u> stage. The Mattaponi Sundowners strongly believe that shooters helping shooters (coaching) is a critical component of the "Cowboy Way" and part of what makes this game great!! Therefore coaching is strongly encouraged and supported.

The Spotters Creed:

If you <u>know</u> that it's a Hit...It's a Hit If you <u>know</u> that it's a Miss...It's a Miss If you <u>think</u> it's a Hit...It's a Hit If you <u>think</u> it's a Miss...IT'S A HIT

Benefit of the doubt always goes to the shooter

STAGE ONE (Bay #2)


Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun

Note: If shooting Josey Wales class substitute two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each for the rifle. If shooting plainsman only shoot the first 5 shots of the rifle sequence (targets listed in red).

Shooting Order: Pistols, Rifle, Shotgun

Staging: Rifle is loaded with 10 rounds, staged on Tall Table. Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered. Shotgun is staged safely.

Procedure: Shooter starts standing at the Hay Bale with hands on pistol butts (both hands maybe on the same pistol), when ready says "**I RECKON SO**". At the beep, with pistols engage pistol targets P4 through P8 in the following order; P4, P5, P6, P5, P4, P8, P7, P6, P7, P8. Then move to the Tall Table and with rifle engage rifle targets R1 through P5 in the following order: **R1**, **R2**, **R3**, **R2**, **R1**, R5, R4, R3, R4, R5. Then make rifle safe, move to the horse and with Shotgun engage shotgun knockdown targets S1 through S4 in any order, all must fall. Pick up long guns and move to the unloading table.



STAGE TWO (Bay #2)


Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun

Note: If shooting Josey Wales class substitute two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each for the rifle. If shooting plainsman only shoot the first 5 shots of the rifle sequence (targets listed in red).

Shooting Order: Shotgun, Rifle, Pistols

Staging: Rifle is loaded with 10 rounds, staged on Tall Table. Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered. Shotgun is staged on Horse.

Procedure: Shooter starts standing at the Horse with hands on Horse, not touching shotgun, when ready says "I **RECKON SO**". At the beep, with shotgun, engage shotgun knockdown targets S1 through S4 in any order, all must fall. Make shotgun safe, move to Tall Table and with rifle engage rifle targets R1 through R5 in the following order: **R1**, **R2**, **R3**, **R4**, **R5**, R5, R4, R3, R2, R1. Then make the rifle safe and with pistols, engage pistol targets P1, P2 and P3 in the following order: P1, P2, P3, P3, P2, P1, P1, P2, P3, P3. Pick up long guns and move to the unloading table.



STAGE THREE (Bay #2)


Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun

Note: If shooting Josey Wales class substitute two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each for the rifle. If shooting plainsman only shoot the first 5 shots of the rifle sequence (targets listed in red).

Shooting Order: Rifle, Shotgun, Pistols

Staging: Rifle is loaded with 10 rounds, staged on Tall Table. Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered. Shotgun is staged safely.

Procedure: Shooter starts standing at the Tall Table with hands on Hat / head, when ready says "**I RECKON SO**". At the beep, with rifle, engage rifle targets R1 through R5 in the following order; **R2**, **R2**, **R3**, **R4**, **R4**, R1, R2, R3, R4, R5. Then make rifle safe on the Tall Table, move to the Horse and with shotgun, engage shotgun knockdown targets S1 through S4 in any order, all must fall. Then make shotgun safe, move to the Hay Bale. Then, with pistols, engage the pistol targets P4 through P8 in the following order; P5, P5, P6, P7, P7, P4, P5, P6, P7, P8. Pick up long guns and move to the unloading table.



STAGE FOUR (Bay #3)


Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun

Note: If shooting Josey Wales class substitute two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each for the rifle. If shooting plainsman only shoot the first 5 shots of the rifle sequence (targets listed in red).

Shooting Order: Shotgun, Rifle, Pistols

Staging: Rifle is loaded with 10 rounds, staged on Tall Table. Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered. Shotgun held with both hands pointing safely down range.

Procedure: Shooter starts standing at the Tall Table holding shotgun, with both hands, pointing safely down range when ready says "I **RECKON SO**". At the beep with shotgun engage shotgun knockdown targets S1 through S4 in any order, all must fall. Then make shotgun safe and with rifle engage rifle targets R1 through R4 in the following order: **R1**, **R1**, **R2**, **R3**, **R4**, R4, R3, R2, R1, R1. Then make rifle safe, move to Barrel and with pistols, engage pistol targets P1 through P4 using same instructions as rifle. Pick up long guns and move to the unloading table.




STAGE FIVE (Bay #3)

Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun

Note: If shooting Josey Wales class substitute two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each for the rifle. If shooting plainsman only shoot the first 5 shots of the rifle sequence (targets listed in red).

Shooting Order: Rifle, Shotgun, Pistols

Staging: Rifle is loaded with 10 rounds, staged on Tall Table. Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered. Shotgun is staged Tall Table.



STAGE SIX (Bay #3)

Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun

Note: If shooting Josey Wales class substitute two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each for the rifle. If shooting plainsman only shoot the first 5 shots of the rifle sequence (targets listed in red).

Shooting Order: Pistols, Rifle, Shotgun

Staging: Rifle is loaded with 10 rounds, staged on Tall Table. Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered. Shotgun is staged safely.

Procedure: Shooter starts standing at the Barrel in default position, when ready says "**I RECKON SO**". At the beep, with pistols, engage the pistol targets P1 through P4 in the following order: P1, P2, P3, P4, P3, P3, P3, P2, P2, P1. Then move to the Tall Table and with rifle, engage rifle targets R1 through R4 in the following order: **R1**, **R2**, **R3**, **R4**, **R3**, R3, R3, R2, R2, R1 then make the rifle safe on Tall Table. Then, with shotgun, engage shotgun knockdown targets S1 through S4 in any order, all must fall. Pick up long guns and move to the unloading table.
